




Importance of Profession Ready Training in Clinical Research





Good Manufacturing Practices





Emerging tech in Pharmaceutical industry

The objective of the camp was to provide information regarding diet, exercise and weight control and counselling on cleanliness along with hygiene & health related issues.










VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN






Free Health Camp" in association with MD Path Lab, Amar Ujala Foundation & Ujala Cignus
